

1. Witmer's Plumbing, Heating & AC, LLC
January 2010

\$180,000 Small Business First Fund (SBFF) low interest loan in support of the machinery and equipment needs of the Greencastle based HVAC company. Funds will also be used to purchase the business assets from the previous owner. The low interest financing represents roughly 40% of the \$441,450 total project cost and is expected to result in the creation of 6 new jobs and the retention of 2 current positions within the next 3 years.

2. Dawson Performance, Inc.

\$157,500 Small Business First Fund (SBFF) low interest loan in support of the purchase of business assets of the former RamTech Machine Shop located on Innovation Way in Chambersburg. The low interest financing availed by the FCADC represents a portion of the \$356,450 total project cost. The business purchase is expected to result in the retention of 4 current jobs while helping to create 3 new positions within the next 3 years.

The PIDA loan represents a portion of the \$1,125,000 total project cost and is expected to result in the creation of 10 new jobs within the next 3 years.
