



## BAE to unveil new MRAP cousin at Letterkenny

CHAMBERSBURG, Monday, June 22 -- The latest relative to the mine-resistant ambush-protected vehicle will be unveiled Tuesday in the Cumberland Valley Business Park. BAE Systems and PM Assured Mobility Systems will roll out the Panther family of vehicles at its plant near Letterkenny Army Depot north of Chambersburg. BAE is producing the Panther for the U.S. Army. The 6-wheel-drive vehicle has a V-shaped hull, designed to protect occupants from unconventional explosives. The vehicle will be used by forward engineers, explosive ordnance disposal units and military intelligence units. The factory, a partnership between York-based BAE U.S. Combat Systems and Letterkenny, has manufactured MRAPs for use in Iraq and Afghanistan.
