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CHAMBERSBURG-WAYNESBORO MSA SEPTEMBER UNEMPLOYMENT RATE 3.7%

HARRISBURG (OCTOBER 30) – The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Chambersburg-Waynesboro Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) was unchanged at 3.7 percent in September. The rate fell one-half of a percentage point from last September. The Chambersburg-Waynesboro MSA's unemployment rate was the fifth-lowest rate among the state's 18 MSAs. The Gettysburg and State College MSAs had the lowest rate at 3.3 percent, while the East Stroudsburg and Johnstown MSAs tied for the highest at 5.2 percent. The September seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Pennsylvania was unchanged from August at 4.1 percent, while the United States rate dropped two-tenths of a percentage point to 3.7 percent.

Franklin County tied Bucks and Perry counties for the eighth-lowest unemployment rate among Pennsylvania's 67 counties in September. Unemployment rates and rankings of the remaining neighboring counties were: Fulton (4.3%, t-24th); Huntingdon (5.5%, 65th); Juniata (4.1%, t-20th); Cumberland (3.2%, 2nd); and Adams (3.3%, t-3rd). Unemployment rates across Pennsylvania ranged from 3.1 percent in Chester County to 6.3 percent in Forest County.

The Chambersburg-Waynesboro MSA's seasonally adjusted total nonfarm jobs were down 300 in September to 61,600. Over the year, jobs were up 1.7 percent (+1,000), while statewide jobs grew 1.3 percent.

Looking at industry detail (not seasonally adjusted), over the month, government had an increase of 300, while education & health services and trade, transportation, & utilities both grew by 200. These were due in part to many schools and colleges beginning their academic year and school bus transportation resuming. Over the year, only one of the seven published supersectors decreased, government (-100). Trade, transportation, & utilities (+400) had the largest gain.

- 1/ Estimate of workers by place of residence. These data are controlled to state Current Population Survey (CPS) data which adjusts for commuting and dual job-holding. Workers are counted where they live only once regardless of the number of jobs they may hold. All in-depth inquiries relative to the estimating methodology should be addressed to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor. All data are subject to revision during annual benchmarking.
- 2/ Includes wage and salary workers (including agriculture), self-employed persons, and unpaid family workers (including agriculture), domestic workers, and persons involved in labor-management disputes.
- 3/ Unemployed as percent of civilian labor force, computed using unrounded data.
