# CHAMBERSBURG-WAYNESBORO MSA OCTOBER UNEMPLOYMENT RATE 6.2%

**Note:** The data contained in this news release reflects the effects of COVID-19 and evolving mitigation efforts to contain it.

HARRISBURG (DECEMBER 1) – The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Chambersburg-Waynesboro Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) was 6.2 percent in October, down 0.7 percentage points from September. The statewide unemployment rate and the national rate both fell 1.0 percentage point over the month to 7.3 and 6.9 percent, respectively.

Seasonally adjusted total nonfarm jobs in the Chambersburg-Waynesboro MSA decreased 0.7 percent from September (-400) to 58,800 in October. Over the year, jobs were down 5.9 percent (-3,700) in the MSA, while statewide jobs declined 7.5 percent.

### October's Not Seasonally Adjusted Nonfarm Jobs Detail (see Table 2)

Over the month, trade, transportation, & utilities added 300 jobs while ramping up for the holiday season. The remaining five published supersectors in the MSA were essentially unchanged.

#### FOOTNOTES

1 Estimate of workers by place of residence. These data are controlled to state Current Population Survey (CPS) data which adjusts for commuting and dual job-holding.

Workers are counted where they live only once regardless of the number of jobs they may hold. All in-depth inquiries relative to the estimating methodology should be addressed to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor. All data are subject to revision during annual benchmarking.

2/ Includes wage and salary workers (including agriculture), self-employed persons, and unpaid family workers (including agriculture), domestic workers, and persons involved in labor-management disputes.

3/ Unemployed as percent of civilian labor force, computed using unrounded data.

4/ Seasonally adjusted MSA level data (and their equivalent) is developed by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS); seasonal adjustment for all other sub-state areas are developed by CWIA.
